# INTRODUCTION

Classification is the cornerstone of Para Karate competition. It defines which athletes are eligible to participate and how they are grouped for fair and meaningful competition. The primary aim is to ensure that the outcome of competition is determined by skill, fitness, power, endurance, tactical ability, and mental focus — rather than the degree of impairment. In this way, classification upholds the integrity and credibility of Para Karate.

Classifiers are specially trained and certified professionals responsible for conducting athlete evaluations in accordance with the World Karate Federation (WKF) Classification Rules. Their role is essential to the fairness of Para Karate at both national and international levels.

This year's program includes:

- Open Seminar (for everyone)
- WKF Classifier Courses Level I & II (for aspiring classifiers)

Aspiring WKF Classifiers and anyone interested in Para Karate are encouraged to sign up for the Open Seminar where you will receive a strong understanding of the procedures and processes involved in Para Karate. Finally, advance your understanding and earn your level I and level II certificates in the Classifier Courses to be held on the occasion of the 2025 WKF Para Karate Championships in Cairo (Egypt). #### Upon completion, you will...

- Able to correctly place athletes in the correct sport class and set the Compensation Score.
- Be able to properly complete all relevant classification documents.
- Know all Minimum Disability Criteria (MDC) and Sport Class.
- Understand and conduct relevant medical and functional tests for Physical Impairment
- Be aware of protest procedures and the impact of misrepresentation on the classification
  And more...

#### **Eligibility**

- Must have a high level of oral and written English.
- Must have 1 of the below requirements...
  - Certified medical professional currently working with individuals who have physical Impairments in their clinical practice.
  - Experience in the evaluation of impairments and activity limitations, such as amputation, orthopedic musculoskeletal conditions, and neurological conditions.
  - Extensive knowledge and experience in the sport of Karate.
  - Knowledge & experience of the competition consistent with WKF Competition Rules.

# **CLASSIFIER COURSE LEVEL II**

#### Eligibility

The candidate for classifier must be recommended by the pertinent National Federation in the application form to attend the International Classifier Training Seminar or be identified as an appropriate professional by the Head of the classification in areas where there is a need for international classifiers.

#### **Medical Classifier**

 A certified health professional in a field relevant to the Impairment category

#### **Technical Classifier**

- An extensive coaching or another relevant background in the sport of Karate;
- Or, a recognized and reputable academic qualification that encompasses a requisite level of anatomical, biomechanical, and sportspecific expertise

# The final evaluation will be a written and practical exam, and an interview.

\*All candidates will need to provide proof that they do not hold a role within their national federation such as team doctor or physiotherapist


